Settlement and distribution of funds raised during the Great Charity Auction "Top Charity 2022" and plans for the next year.

Thanks to the substantial sum of **8,792,000 PLN** raised during the first edition of the Grand Charity Auction TOP CHARITY 2022, we were able to execute many projects of the Omenaa Foundation and Rafal Brzoska Foundation. Due to the fact that the past year was very difficult politically and economically, especially for war-ridden Ukraine, the largest part of the amount was allocated to relief projects for Ukraine. This was followed by educational and psychological support for children from Polish orphanages, the Kids Haven School in Ghana as well as scientific and social scholarships for gifted Polish youth.

Helping children of the streets in Ghana

In Ghana, more than 623,500 children do not attend elementary school and one in four children at preschool age does not go to kindergarten. More than 30% of the population between the ages of 15 and 25 can't read or write. It is estimated that approximately 20,000 to 40,000 children are being forced into slave labour around Lake Volta.

The Kids' Haven School is a destination for children of the streets in Ghana who were sold and worked as slave labourers. At our centre, many of them slept in a bed or used the bathroom for the first time. Some of them had never gone to school. We developed an original program especially for them: I write, I read, I speak.

Helping refugees from Afghanistan

Additionally, we will fund an intensive Polish language course for refugees from Afghanistan preparing for medical school exams and wanting to continue their studies at Polish universities. We are currently supporting 40 people. The project is conducted jointly with the Medical University of Warsaw.

Help for Ukraine

More than 1.5 million people came to Poland from war-stricken Ukraine (that's how many people were given Personal Identification Numbers), and over 7 million passed through Poland as a transit country. Support and care is still in demand, especially for women and children. That is why our Foundation decided to launch a daycare centre for women and children from Ukraine – RiO Edu Centrum. In addition, we have supported several other relief projects.

 A joint project with Warsaw Medical University – we financially support the training of 400 Ukrainian doctors in the field of battlefield medicine. We have provided the doctors and medical assistants with 500 first aid tactical kits and modern training phantoms. Total 	519 600 PLN 3 021 600 PLN

 RiO Vibe Centrum – we have created a mental health clinic for Ukrainian children and wards of orphanages, responding to alarming statistics: In 2022, the National Police Headquarters recorded 2,031 suicide attempts by children and adolescents. The desire to take one's own life is one of the final symptoms of depression. The average waiting time for a child's psychiatric consultation is about two years. We have 4 professional psychological support offices: Our staff consists of a qualified and experienced team of therapists: 3 psychologists from Ukraine, 2 psychologists from Poland as well as a sensory integration therapist. The professional content of our classes is supervised by an experienced clinical psychologist, a psychotherapist, and a forensic sexologist. Monthly, we accommodate more than 300 people, to whom we offer a wide range of support in the area of mental health. 	582 000 PLN RiO Vibe Centrum's annual budget

Support for Polish children's homes

At the end of 2021, 72,300 children, completely or partially deprived of their natural family care were in foster custody. Only 6% of them obtain tertiary education. We want to change this!

9 children's homes with 130 wards are under the permanent care of our foundation. In addition, we cooperate with 15 institutions that house 252 children.


The total funding pledged as an initiation quota of the Foundation, amounting to over 4,000,000 PLN, was allocated for the fulfilment of the educational needs of the Foundation's wards. Most of them are studying at prestigious universities such as: Oxford, Cambridge, Berkeley, Wharton School of Management, New York University, or the Karolinska Institutet. Recruitment for the second instalment of the scholarship competition is coming soon.

Our plans and dreams for the future.

In the coming months, we want to continue the mission of both Foundations by:

- Running the school and support centre for the children of the streets in Ghana. We also want to build a sports
 complex available to our wards and members of the local community. In addition, we wish to support two
 schools, including one built near the largest garbage dump in Africa.
- As long as the war in Ukraine continues, our RiO Edu Centrum will remain open for refugees.
- We are also committed to expanding our RiO Vibe offer and extending psychological care to more and more children.
- We will continue to provide support for the education of children in foster homes. Moreover, this year we plan to organise summer camps, offering a well-deserved break and an opportunity to develop and discover their strengths.
- We are currently working on a unique venue in the heart of Warsaw's Praga district called Mini City. Developed by the Omenaa Art Foundation, the project aims to inspire a love for art and promote the ideas of ecology and upcycling for young children.
- The Rafał Brzoska Foundation will also continue to support the education of its beneficiaries, with the winners
 of the second scholarship competition joining their group during the summer.

Our Foundations have a boutique approach, which minimises administrative costs to only 20% of the project budget.
